

Report on the Development of ETD-MS Export Plugin in EPrints

The implementation of ETD\_MS export plugin follows EPrints system's plugin development guideline<sup>1</sup>. A new module (ETD\_MS.pm) is placed at: /opt/eprints3/perl\_lib/EPrints/Plugin/Export.

The ETD\_MS export plugin needs to inherit from the EPrints::Plugin::Export class,

```
@ISA = ( "EPrints::Plugin::Export" );
```

The implementation of method *output\_dataobj* handles the export of each *DataObj*, which is the super class of EPrints data type *EPrint*, *Document*, and *User*. With the method *convert\_dataobj*, we extract the metadata fields of each DataObj required by ETD\_MS schema<sup>2</sup>.

The following table shows the mapping between ETD\_MS element and the correspondent EPrints metadata field. Custom fields that we added are highlighted.

The ETD\_MS.pl export script implementation is available in EPrints Files<sup>6</sup>

According to the standard, the ETD-MS field “thesis.discipline” is to contain the “Area of study of the intellectual content of the document. Usually, this will be the name of a program or department.”
